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SUBJECT: Product Rationalization of 721 Engine Controls

This announcement is to inform Woodward Customers, Channel Partners, and Sales & Marketing of the updated product rationalization and product support plan for the 721 product line manufactured by Woodward.

This announcement replaces Woodward's original product support statement on the 721 product line, which was issued on 3 December 2002.

Due to the increasing support costs, lack of obtainable components, and declining sales, Woodward has resolved to cease production of these products in the near future.

Woodward offers the following "Last Time Buy" scenario for the discontinued items:

- Orders for the Last Time Buy can be placed until 30 June 2015. Woodward will accept orders until this date.
- Woodward will ship items ordered before the LTB date until 30 September 2015 based on the LTB volumes and subject to parts availability. After this date, Woodward will stop production of these items.

Woodward will commit to the following product line support plan for the discontinued items:

15 November 2014 to 30 June 2015

- New Sales subject to parts availability
- Unlimited Repairs

1 July 2015 to 30 June 2020

Limited Repairs based on parts availability

Customers are encouraged to contact their account manager to discuss alternatives to the 721. There is no direct replacement of the 721, but other controllers may function as suitable replacements with limited re-engineering work.
