SUBJECT: Obsolescence of 9907-205, Handheld Programmer

The Handheld programmer has been an important tool used along with some legacy Woodward products. However, due to declining demand, significant cost pressures and supply shortages of some key components used in the product, Woodward has resolved to cease production of the product effective immediately. Despite the ongoing semiconductor shortage, Woodward has procured last time buy stock of these obsolete components to facilitate better planned obsolescence and enable last-time-buy for our customers to support service stock. Please contact your Customer Account Manager and make arrangements for last time order.

The Woodward part numbers impacted are 9907-205 (Programmer - Hand Held, CE compliant, 4-piece kit) 1790-865 programmer, and 1626-533 case.

Note – Component obsolescence from electronic manufacturers can present a challenge to post-life support plans. Woodward strives to hold inventory or look for alternative parts when the components we use are no longer available. However, there are times when components simply cannot be obtained and where sufficient last-time buys cannot be made. Unfortunately, in these cases Woodward cannot guarantee the rationalization support plan.
